Monthly Observing Nights We have a dark sky observing site located on a hilltop near Mounds, OK. Our site features an acre lawn and the ACT Observatory and classroom. The observatory houses a 14 inch RCX 400 telescope plus we have several smaller telescopes available for use. As a member you will be able to share in our observing activities at the observatory and enjoy a panoramic view of the sky and countryside. Monthly Observing opportunities include: **ACT Monthly Star party** open to individuals and families. (Groups need to make separate reservations.) **Admission is \$ 2.00 per person for non-members.**

Public Observing Night A monthly evening where we invite guests to visit the observatory and members set up telescopes to share the wonders of the night sky.

MEMBERS ONLY Observing Night is held near the new moon for club members to work on observing projects. All events are subject to Weather cancellations.
